



## STATEMENT OF FACTS

On Tuesday, December 24, 2019, at approximately 0044 hours, I was contacted directly by Lieutenant Fred Geiger, B Troop Headquarters, regarding an a possible home invasion and assault and battery in the Town of Leverett. Specifically, uniformed Troopers, assigned to the State Police Northampton Barracks were currently dispatched to [REDACTED] Leverett. Lieutenant Geiger requested that I contact Sergeant Stephen Burgess, who was at the scene, for more information.

In speaking with Sergeant Burgess, I learned that he responded to the Leverett residence after a female party, identified as Rie Hachiyanagi ([REDACTED]), contacted E911/Northampton Dispatch, on this date at approximately 0012 hours, to report that she arrived at the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] residence and located her friend, later identified as [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]), lying on the floor of the residence barely breathing, semi-conscious and with a head injury. Further, Ms. Hachiyanagi reported that there were signs of a struggle inside the residence and an exterior door found partially opened. Upon arrival at the scene, Sergeant Burgess reported that he discovered the victim and Ms. Hachiyanagi lying together on the floor, in a foyer area, on the first floor. Responding personnel then searched the house, and multiple out buildings, in an effort to locate a third party, with negative results. While on the phone with Sergeant Burgess, I could hear him speaking with Ms. Hachiyanagi. He asked her what brought her to the residence and her response was that she had made plans with [REDACTED] to come to her residence, at approximately 2300 hours, and found her friend inside her home and in need of medical attention. The victim further reported to Trooper Taylor Powers that she did not know the gender or any other identifying descriptors for the alleged suspect/suspects.

At approximately 0240 hours, Sergeant Gary Darling spoke with Ms. Hachiyanagi at the scene. In summary, during an audio recorded interview, Ms. Hachiyanagi reported that she and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] knew each other as they were both professors at Mount Holyoke College, South Hadley. Ms. Hachiyanagi alleged that her boyfriend/life partner left the Western Massachusetts area to visit family out of state. Ms. Hachiyanagi was concerned that her relationship (Hachiyanagi's relationship) with her boyfriend was coming to an end. Ms. Hachiyanagi then went on to give Sergeant Darling a very detailed timeline of how she spent her day. Ms. Hachiyanagi reported that on the morning of December 23<sup>rd</sup>, she rented a vehicle from Enterprise Rental Car in Northampton. Despite having a functioning vehicle registered to her, she opted to rent a vehicle, a Toyota Rav4, because it was an SUV style. It rode higher off the ground and it made her feel alive. After renting the vehicle, she then traveled to [REDACTED] residence, at approximately 1100 hours, and delivered a poinsettia plant to her. She stated she only delivered the plant, to [REDACTED], and did not enter the residence. Ms. Hachiyanagi claimed that she came to the residence to give [REDACTED] emotional support as she [REDACTED] was still waiting to hear about a possible cancer diagnosis. After leaving the Leverett residence, Ms. Hachiyanagi traveled to a restaurant, in the Town of Whately, and spent approximately two (2) hours there. At

approximately 1300 hours, she returned the rental car to Enterprise and then traveled to various locations in Hampshire and Franklin Counties before meeting with [REDACTED] again.

Ms. Hachiyanagi met with [REDACTED] at Mount Holyoke College, at approximately 1600 hours, and claimed that the pair made plans to meet at [REDACTED] Leverett residence later that evening (December 23<sup>rd</sup>). She then reportedly went back to her residence in South Hadley. At approximately 1800 hours, Ms. Hachiyanagi then reportedly drove to a martial arts studio in Amherst, but stayed in the parking lot as she was missing her boyfriend/life partner (also an instructor at the martial arts studio). Despite giving a detail account of her day, Ms. Hachiyanagi reportedly pulled out of the martial arts studio in Amherst, traveling NB on Route 116, and alleged that she did not remember anything after leaving that parking lot. Ms. Hachiyanagi alleged that her medical history, which included multiple concussions, affected her memory. She claimed she suffered the most recent concussion in June 2019 when she was in a car crash. She was adamant that when she arrived at [REDACTED] residence that she found [REDACTED] on the floor, in a pool of blood and in a semi-conscious state. Ms. Hachiyanagi stated that when she discovered her friend, she held her. She claimed that was the reason she had blood visible on her clothing at the time she spoke with investigators. According to Ms. Hachiyanagi, [REDACTED] reported to her that she [REDACTED] had been attacked by an unknown assailant. [REDACTED] allegedly was unable to give Ms. Hachiyanagi any other information about the alleged assailant. Ms. Hachiyanagi verified that she was the reporting party of the incident and used her cell phone to contact police. However, her phone allegedly fell in the toilet, during the call, and that accounted for why she was initially disconnected from State Police Dispatch.

At approximately 0215 hours, Trooper Christopher Dolan, assigned to the Crime Scene Services Section, and I met with attending physician Dr. Michael Zhou. Dr. Zhou offered a preliminary opinion that [REDACTED] presented with multiple broke bones in her nose/eyes area and that she also had numerous lacerations and puncture wounds on her head and face. He did not consider her injuries life threatening.

At approximately 0347 hours, Trooper Dolan and I met with [REDACTED] in a triage room at Baystate Medical Center. She was lying on her back, in a C spine collar, on a hospital gurney. I observed that her eyes were almost purple in color and swollen shut. I also observed numerous lacerations and puncture wounds to her head and facial areas. In summary, during an audio recorded interview, [REDACTED] uttered that she knew the identity of the person who attacked her. [REDACTED] reported that Rie Hachiyanagi, a fellow professor from Mount Holyoke College, caused her injuries. [REDACTED] stated that she had known Ms. Hachiyanagi since August 2005 and that the pair were friends. They had never been in a dating relationship; and, in fact, Ms. Hachiyanagi was in a long term relationship with a male party. [REDACTED] went on to report that, on December 23<sup>rd</sup>, at approximately 1000 hours; Ms. Hachiyanagi arrived unannounced at her Leverett residence and presented her [REDACTED] with a poinsettia plant. [REDACTED] stated that Ms. Hachiyanagi had never been to her residence before despite having been friends for many years. She later saw Ms. Hachiyanagi a second time, on the college campus in South Hadley, at

approximately 1600 hours. [Ms. Savoy] reported that their conversation was benign and the pair parted ways with the understanding that they would speak again in the New Year. [Ms. Savoy] was adamant that she did not make plans with Ms. Hachiyanagi later in the evening.

[redacted] then went on to report that that she arrived home to her Leverett residence, at approximately 2000 hours. Shortly after arriving home, she saw what she believed was a shadow on the deck of the residence. Instead of contacting 911, [redacted] asked who was there. At that time, Ms. Hachiyanagi emerged from the darkness. According to [redacted], Ms. Hachiyanagi stated that she really missed her and wanted to talk with her about feelings. [redacted] encouraged her friend to enter the residence. When she turned away from the door, and was less than a foot inside the door, [redacted] reported that Ms. Hachiyanagi hit her on the back of the head with "something hard". [Ms. Savoy] stated she was stunned by the initial blow and landed on the floor. She reported that Ms. Hachiyanagi then continued "hitting" her repeatedly on the head. [Ms. Savoy] reported that she attempted to defend herself by blocking the blows. When [Ms. Savoy] asked her attacker why she was assaulting her, Ms. Hachiyanagi reportedly said that she loved her [redacted] for many years and that she [redacted] should have known. During the almost hour long interview, [redacted] reported that despite losing her glasses, and her vision compromised, she saw Ms. Hachiyanagi strike her [redacted] with multiple implements to include fists, rocks, garden clippers and what she described was a fire poker (All items were later recovered, by investigators, at the scene). [redacted] stated that she thought she was going to die at the hands of Ms. Hachiyanagi. In an effort to appear sympathetic to her attacker, she [redacted] reported that she lied and told Ms. Hachiyanagi that she really did love her. She stated that when she told Ms. Hachiyanagi that she seemed to calm down for a short period of time, but then the suspect reportedly hit her with the fire poker. Ms. Hachiyanagi stated that she really thought that was "the end". She also recalled, that at some point during the attack, Ms. Hachiyanagi allegedly stated that if she let [redacted] go, she [redacted] would tell someone. That would result in Ms. Hachiyanagi going to jail. Ms. Hachiyanagi reportedly told [redacted] that if she went to jail, she would kill herself. [redacted] went on to report that by playing along with Ms. Hachiyanagi, she was able to convince her to call 911 and get police to respond to the residence.

[redacted] was very upfront that she did not tell anyone who responded to the scene or initial treating medical personnel that Ms. Hachiyanagi was the attacker. [Ms. Savoy] reported that she was terrified that Ms. Hachiyanagi would harm her again or even burn down her residence. She also reported that she was afraid that Ms. Hachiyanagi would arrive at the hospital to bring her [redacted] her glasses, cell phone and house keys.

At approximately 0709 hours, Ms. Hachiyanagi was arrested at the Leverett residence. At that time, the victim's keys, cell phone and glasses were found to be on her person.

Based on the aforementioned facts and circumstances, I believe there is probable cause to believe that on December 23-December 24, 2019, in the Town of Leverett, Massachusetts, Rei Hachiyanagi ([redacted]), [redacted] whose last known address is [redacted]

South Hadley, Massachusetts violated M.G.L. c. 265 § 14-A, Mayhem, M.G.L. c. 265§ 18A, Assault to Murder on Person Over 60 Years of Age While Armed, M.G.L. 265 § 15A-B, Assault and Battery Dangerous Weapon (to wit rock) on a Person Over 60 Years of Age, M.G.L. 265 § 15A-B, Assault and Battery Dangerous Weapon (to wit fire poker) on a Person Over 60 Years of Age, M.G.L. 265 § 15A-B, Assault and Battery Dangerous Weapon (to wit garden clippers) on a Person Over 60 Years of Age and M.G.L. 265 § 18A Armed Assault in a Dwelling. I respectfully request the Court to issue a complaint against Rie Hachiyanagi [REDACTED] for the above violations.
